

Golf Attire

Suitable golf attire is required at all times. Ladies shirts and blouses must have collars or sleeves. Any shorts, slacks or skirts made of denim material are not allowed. Also, cut-off shorts, t-shirts, halter tops and metal spikes are prohibited. Proper footwear is required. There are some special theme events where other attire is allowed.

Pace of Play and Etiquette

An important element of golf etiquette is maintaining the pace of play. Here are some tips to keep your game moving:

- Be at the course, signed in and ready to play 30 minutes before your Tee-Time.
- Enter scores on Golf Genius or your score card at the next tee, allowing those behind you to move forward.
- Keep up with the group in FRONT of you.
- Play ready golf - if you are at your ball and ready to hit, you may do so, even if another player is away but not yet ready to hit. (Use discretion; do not interfere with another player's shot or place yourself in danger); if playing in a Match Play Competition, you should make every attempt to play "honors" but not slow down pace of play.
- Take a few clubs with you if you are unsure of which club you want to use when approaching your ball. That way you do not have to return to the cart to get a club.
- Drop your cart mate at her ball if it's far away from your ball and then go to your ball. Once you have hit the ball, return to pick up your cart mate.

Pace of Play and Etiquette Continues...

- At the putting green, be sure to park your cart towards the back or behind the green for a quick exit to the next hole.
- Know the rules - keep a copy of the rules book in your bag. Ask if you don't know.
- If a team or an individual violates any rules, the team or individual will be disqualified.
- Observe the 90 degree rule whenever possible.
- Please be considerate and no talking or phone usage while others are addressing and hitting the ball.
- It is all right to give a distance measurement and it is also all right to ask for one.

Have fun with the women you are playing with and enjoy our beautiful golf course and all the amazing wildlife. Friendly reminder to please fill your divots and ball marks. This golf course belongs to all of us, so please be thoughtful.

About LLGA

The membership is open to any female Member of Lexington Country Club upon payment of annual dues. A Member cannot hold dual Membership in both the Ladies 18 Hole and the Ladies 9 Hole Association, although a Member may switch from one to the other once per year. All Members must have established USGA handicaps that is (5) 18 hole scores within 12 months. The maximum number of handicap strokes cannot exceed 40 for 18 holes per USGA recommendations.

The LLGA sponsors Ladies Day golf tournaments on most Thursday mornings at 8am during season. These golf events are both individual and team competitions. In addition, LLGA sponsors other major golf events throughout the season. Volunteer committees run these events with the backing of the Executive Board. You are encouraged to join one of these committees as they are a great deal of fun and give you the opportunity to meet many of the wonderful and talented women at Lexington. Sign up for these committees at the end of each season.

There is a normal annual fee of \$35 to join LLGA. This fee is used to defray costs of LLGA events and prizes and will be charged to your Lexington account by the LCC bookkeeper when you first join. There is no need to sign up each year; your account will be automatically charged by November 1st or prior to the first day of play. If you choose to withdraw from the LLGA before November 1st, you must alert the LCC bookkeeper and your account will not be charged.

PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU MOVE WITHIN LEXINGTON, YOU MUST NOTIFY ACCOUNTING TO SWITCH YOUR MEMBERSHIP TO YOU NEW MEMBER NUMBER.

Ladies Day & Event Sign - Up

Members are encouraged to use Golf Genius on the Lexington website to sign up for Ladies Days and special events. If needed, the Pro-Shop can assist you. If at all possible, Members are asked NOT to cancel after Tee-Times are set, especially if it is a team event, as it puts a burden on the Golf Professionals to rearrange the foursomes.

Competitions

All competitions will be played in accordance with the USGA rules and any local rules that may be in effect at the time of play. Local rules can be found on our website and the Pro-Shop.

Posting Scores

Golf Genius live mobile scoring will be utilized for all league events. After play, scores will be automatically posted on GHIN by the Golf Staff. If you are unsure how to set this up on your phone, please see someone in the Pro-Shop. You can also find information about Golf Genius on our Ladies 18 Hole webpage.

LLGA "2 Club" Local Rules

To be a Member of the LLGA 2 Club, you should declare your participation at the start of your round. Anytime you score a 2 on a hole (Birdie on a par 3; Eagle on a par 4) all "2 Club" Members playing with you will pay you \$1.00. Likewise, if you are playing with another Member of the "2 Club" and they score a 2 on a hole, you will pay them \$1.00.

Gator Girl Shootout

The Gator Girl Shootout Started at Lexington Country Club in 2010. It is played by the 10 LLGA Members who have accumulated the most points during the LLGA season.

The points are awarded as follows:

5 points for playing Ladies Day Events: 3 extra points for 1st place; 2 extra points for 2nd place; 1 extra point for 3rd place. In addition, 1 point for low gross and 1 pt for low net.

The women who qualify for this event play a 9-hole "Shootout". All 10 women tee-off on the first hole. One player is eliminate on each hole until the winner is determined.

Everyone is invited to follow the players as they compete in this tournament to see who the next Gator Girl will be.

LLGA Events

- “In Class” means A&B players are flighted together and C&D players are flighted together.
- ABCD refers to players with four different handicaps. A player, B player, etc.
- “A” player is the lowest handicap player on the team.
- “BB” means “Better Ball”, for example, 2 BB of four. The best 2 scores of the four players counts for the score.
- There is a separate brochure called “Lexington Ladies 18 Hole Golf Games” which describes all the games we play in a given season.
- For the “Pick Your Own Foursome” events, if you do not have a foursome, the Pro-Shop will put you together with other women playing in the event.

Match Play Tournament

This is a major tournament sponsored by the Pro-Shop and is not a Ladies Day Event, although it is scheduled on Ladies Day. Participants will be charged a tournament fee for this event, and will be able to earn General Manager (GM) points. A description of which tournament events participants are eligible for GM points is available at the desk in the Pro-Shop. Ladies not participating in the Match Play Tournament will be able to sign-up for Ladies Day,

Gulf Coast Interclub

Typically playsix times per year, October through April. LLGA Members are invited to represent Lexington in golf matches against other Golf Clubs. Women will be capped at a handicap of 32 or less and must meet the 5 gold tees requirement. Details are posted in the Ladies Locker Room on the LLGA bulletin board and on our Ladies 18 Hole webpage. If you have any questions, feel free to contact the Gulf Coast Interclub Reps.

Lee County Interclub II

Typically play six times per year, October through March with play-offs in April. LLGA Members are invited to represent Lexington in golf matches against other Golf Clubs. There is a minimum handicap INDEX of 18 and a maximum handicap INDEX of 36. Details are posted in the Ladies Locker Room on the LLGA bulletin board and on our Ladies 18 Hole Webpage. If you have any questions, feel free to contact the Lee County Interclub II Reps.

Lee County Ladies Interclub

Typically play six times per year, October through March with year end event in April. LLGA Members are invited to represent Lexington in golf matches against other Golf Clubs. There is a maximum handicap INDEX allowed of 25.5 Details are posted in the Ladies Locker Room on the LLGA bulletin board and on our Ladies 18 Hole Webpage. If you have any questions, feel free to contact the Lee County Interclub II Reps.

You must be a member to play in LLGA sponsored events and to participate in the “Birdies” and “Chip-In Program” on Ladies Days in season. The LLGA pays you \$3.00 for a Birdie and \$3.00 for a Chip-In. Be sure to place your “birdie” on the Tree located in the locker room. In addition, only LLGA Members are able to win a cash prize of \$100.00 if she gets a Hole-In-One on any LLGA sponsored Ladies Day or Event.

Ambassador Program

New LLGA Members can be assigned to a current league Member for orientation purposes. This optional mentorship program will be individually designed with the goal of introducing the new Member to current Members and assisting the new Member to the league’s schedules and format

Cancellations

The Golf Professionals will determine whether or not the day's event will be postponed or cancelled due to weather conditions. If the event is played as scheduled, those who did not show up will forfeit. It is the responsibility of each player to check with the Pro-Shop.

Lexington Hole - In - One Club

The Hole-In-One Club was established to recognize the Hole-In-One as the most significant singular achievement in the game of golf. To defray the increasing cost of honoring the age old tradition of "hosting a round of drinks" to celebrate this achievement, a "Member Owned Fund" was created to spread the cost of this tradition among all Hole-In-One Club Members. This was adopted as a form of Member "insurance". Presently, a Member getting a Hole-In-One will get a \$350.00 credit for BEVERAGES ONLY at any of the open bars in the Lexington Community. This credit must be used within five days (it does not have to be used all at one time) and the Hole-In-One Club Member must be present when the credit is being used. In addition, the Hole-In-One Club Member will also get a \$150.00 credit for sweeps at the Pro-Shop. This credit must be used before April 30th. To become a Member of the Hole-In-One Club, please sign up through the Pro-Shop. Members will be assessed a small fee every time a Club Member gets a Hole-In-One to refurbish the money in the "Member Owned Fund".
