

T's and F's – a Team or Individual Event

Each player will record their Gross score. At the end of the round, Golf Genius will only count the Net scores that were recorded on the holes that begin with “T” and “F”.

1 Better Ball of 2 – a Team Event

Each player will record their Gross (actual) score per hole. Golf Genius will convert to net scores. The lowest net score on each hole will count for the “team score”. Low total wins!

Sweet Sixteen – a Team or Individual Event

Each player will record their Gross (actual) score. Golf Genius will “throw out” the 2 worst scores in relation to par, leaving your “Sweet 16” score used for the event.

Quota Game – a Team or Individual Event

Quota is determined by subtracting your handicap from 40. For example, if you have a 20 handicap, $40-20=20$. Quota is 20 points. Record Gross scores, Golf Genius will convert to points as follows:

Bogey – One Point

Par – Two Points

Birdie – Four Points

Eagle – Eight Points

The goal is to make as many points as possible to hit or exceed your “quota”!

2 Best Balls of 4 on Even Holes, 3 Best Balls of 4 on Odd Holes

Players record their own Gross Score per hole. Golf Genius will convert to net scores for the event. For even holes, the 2 lowest net scores will be counted. For odd holes, the 3 lowest net scores will be counted. Low total wins! If there are only 3 players on the team, the team will receive a blind draw for each missing player at the end of the round. The professional golf staff will take care of this.

6/6/6—a Team Event

The 18 holes are divided into 3 mini games. 6 holes of team scramble, 6 holes of 2 BB of 4 and the final 6 holes of 4-person alternate shot.

Viva Las Vegas— a Team Event

At the beginning of play, each player is assigned a suit (heart, diamond, club, spade). There is a suited card at each tee box; the player's score who matches the suit must be used on the previous hole. If it's a joker, the best score will be used.

Divine 9— a Team or Individual Event

Everyone plays their own ball. At the end of the round, the best 3 Par 3s, best 3 Par 4s and best 3 Par 5s for a total of 9 holes.

Pinehurst— 2 Person Event

Each player hits their own tee shot. One the second shot player will hit each others tee shot and continue playing your partners tee shot until the ball is holed.

The following is a list of the games played by the LLGA. Please note that some games are Individual Events and others are Team Events. Some Team Events are grouped in an A,B,C,D format, which means that the team has an "A" player, a "B" player, a "C" player and a "D" player. An "A" player has the lowest handicap, etc. Other Team Events are "In Class" which means that four "A" players are on the same team, 4 "B" players are on the same team, etc. It may also be that "A" and "B" players will play together and "C" and "D" players will play together.

For all games, players should report their GROSS (actual) score in Golf Genius where the system will adjust your score accordingly for the game of the day.

Posting: Scores will be automatically posted via Golf Genius after play. An explanation of golf Genius can be found on the 18 Hole Ladies webpage.

4 Person Scramble - a Team Event

Each player hits a tee shot, then the team will choose the ball resting in the best position and each player will play a ball from that position. This continues until the ball is holed. All shots must be taken from within 12 inches of the selected shot, 6 inches on green, no nearer the hole, and the ball must stay in the same condition (rough, bunker, hazard, etc.) If you have a threesome, each player will play 2 shots for 6 consecutive holes. In this format, each player usually must have 3 drives.

Individual Stableford (Net) - an Individual Event

Each player will be awarded points for her NET score on each hole using Golf Genius. The points are awarded as follows:

Net Bogey – 1 Point
Net Par – 2 Points
Net Birdie – 3 Points
Net Eagle – 4 Points
Net Double Eagle – 5 Points

Player with the most points wins!

Team Stableford - 2 BB of 4

Similar to Individual Stableford (above), gross scores are converted to net points via Golf Genius. The 2 highest net points on each hole will be used as the team score. High total wins!

Low Gross, Low Net - an Individual Event

Each player will record their Gross (actual) score for each hole. Golf Genius will convert to net scores. Low scores will either win low gross or low net (never both).

Women in the Middle

Each person plays her own ball. Record all 4 gross scores in Golf Genius. The team score is the two "middle" net scores for each hole (add the two scores together). The "best" and "worst" individual scores are not used as part of the team score. For example, if the net scores are 3,4,5,6, the team score will be 4+5 or 9. Golf Genius will determine the net scores.

O.N.E.S. – a Team or Individual Event

Players record scores for each hole. At the end of the round, Golf Genius will automatically select the holes that begin with letters O,N,E and S and add up the Gross and Net scores for these holes. The total of these scores are the scores that are recorded for the game. At times, only gross scores will count; other times only net scores will count.

2 Best Balls of 4 - a Team Event

Players record their own Gross (actual) score per hole. Golf Genius will convert to net scores. Golf Genius will count the 2 lowest net scores on each hole. If there are only 3 players on the team, the team will receive a blind draw for each missing player at the end of the round. The professional golf staff will take care of this.

3 Best Balls of 4 - a Team Event

Similar to 2 Best Balls of 4 (above), Golf Genius will count the 3 lowest net scores on each hole. Low total wins!

2 Best Balls of 4 with Corners

Similar to 2 Best Balls of 4 (above), Golf Genius will count the 2 lowest net scores on each hole, except for the "corners". Holes 1, 9, 10 & 18 are deemed the corners. On these holes, all 4 balls will be counted! Low total wins!

3,2,1 Best Ball

Similar to 2 Best Balls of 4 (above), Golf Genius will count the 3 lowest net scores on the par 3's, 2 lowest net scores on the par 4's & 1 lowest net score on the par 5's. Low total wins!

CHA, CHA, CHA – a Team Event

Each Player will record their actual Gross score per hole. Golf Genius will convert to net scores. Like the dance cadence, we will play 1,2,3....1,2,3.

Hole #1 – 1 Best Ball of the 4 players
Hole #2 – 2 Best Balls of the 4 players
Hole # 3 – 3 Best Balls of the 4 players
Hole # 4 – 1 Best Ball of 4 again
Hole # 5 – 2 Best Balls of 4; etc.

Keep in mind that this pattern continues whether or not you are playing a par 3, a par 4 or a par five hole until the round is finished.

Favorite 15

Each player will record their Gross (actual) score for each hole. Golf Genius will convert to net scores. Your 3 worst scores in relation to par will be "thrown out" . This will leave you with 15 holes counting as your net score for the event.

Surprise Holes

The Golf Pro "throws out" the team scores from a predetermined number, usually 2 or 3 holes, to create a new team score. The holes from which scores will be eliminated are not shared until after play is completed.
